Dear Potential 2010 Parade Participant:

The Manchester St. Patrick's Parade Committee invites you to participate in our Fourteenth Annual community celebration in the Queen City. The Parade will step off at noon on Sunday, March 28, 2010. We sincerely hope you are able to join us that day.

If you intend to be involved in the 2010 Parade, please fill out the enclosed Participation Agreement and return it to me promptly. An envelope is included for your convenience.

As in the past, guidance on Participant Safety will be sent to you before the parade date. Continuing for 2010, although you may already know these things, be aware of these cautions: No candy or other items can be thrown from vehicles or floats (this rule, around since our Parade's inception, still stands); there must be at least 8-inch guardrails around the edge of all floats and flatbeds; children on a float must be accompanied by an appropriate number of adults; we recommend floats or flatbeds do not have wheels outside of the trailer.

Note, same as last year, we include for your reference a sample Certificate of Insurance. Please ask your insurance agent to prepare an actual Certificate showing your Organization's coverages and send it to me at the above address.

Also enclosed is a 2010 Parade Fee Quote page. This is what we will consider in light of the overall budget for the 2010 Parade.

Driving directions, assembly areas, the Parade route and related particulars will be sent to you approximately March 1, 2010.
